The two letters may be written by whomever you choose (e.g., CTE instructors, supervisors, mentors and/or community members) and must be included with your completed application packet. **Please note: Letters of reference must be written by individuals other than the teacher who completes the CTE Teacher Evaluation Form.**

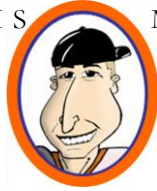
